

Parents Voice Notes from the Meeting held on 9th July 2026

While these notes do not record every conversation in detail, they highlight the main themes we discussed and include all information that was requested.

Agenda Items:

1. DPR

- Issues with DPR as a communication tool – not as effective as Edulink – look at providing consistency in communications.
- Parents would like notifications – although the system does not operate these.
- Inconsistency in frequency of teachers completing DPR.
- More communications around end of term DPR updates.

2. GCSE Statistics

- The lack of communication about this has led to some unease. Moving forwards, the school will be proactive in communicating to parents. Year 8 have already been informed about this for next year.
- Communicate the vision more fully behind the move to GCSE Statistics

3. Sports Camps

- Is there any funding for those students who may not be able to afford these?
As the trips are categorised as extra-curricular, they do not attract additional or supportive funding. We do try to run them at cost and try to find the most affordable options for families.

4. AOB

- Clarity on PE Kits and making sure that trainers are black and part of the kit. Some parents have felt under pressure to buy new trainers.
