Using Xbox or PlayStation to Access Teams

<u>Xbox</u>

- 1. Plug a keyboard in to the Xbox USB slot
- 2. Go in to my games and apps
- 3. Find Microsoft Edge and select
- 4. Type in: Teams log in
- 5. Sign in with your school e-mail and password. You can then access your lessons and work through Teams

To move around you use the Xbox controller or plug in a mouse

PlayStation

- 1. Identify the PlayStation internet browser icon (it is WWW with dots around it)
- 2. Press the PlayStation logo on the controller
- 3. Go to the library and find options for games and applications
- 4. Go in to applications and you will find the internet browser
- 5. Type in Teams log in
- 6. Sign in with your school e-mail and password. You can then access your lessons and work through Teams
