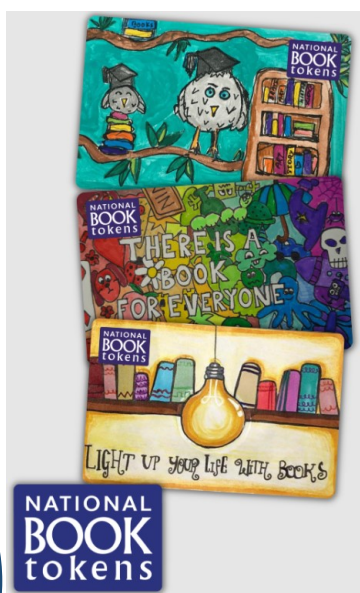


DESIGN TIPS

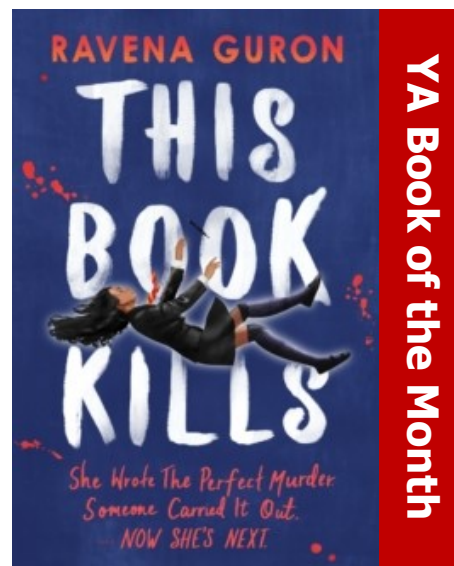

There's a murderer on the loose in an elite boarding school... But who is going to be next?

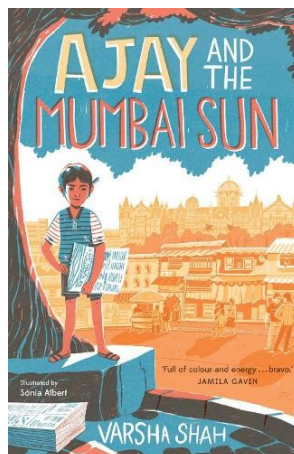
