Core Maths

- This is a new Level 3 course for students who are not taking A Level Maths but would like to continue studying Maths.
- Students need a B grade at GCSE to take this course.
- This a 2 year course leading to an AS equivalent qualification. There is no controlled assessment. There will be two examinations in the summer of Year 13
- Students may take this course in addition to three AS courses in Year 12.
- There will be three hours per week of teaching time BUT it may need to be timetabled in period 7 to fit around your other subjects.
